## Oriental bittersweet look alike



Invasive Oriental bittersweet (*Celastrus orbiculatus*) and Asian bittersweet (*Celastrus loeseneri*) have the same characteristics and are easily confused with the native American bittersweet (*Celastrus scadens*).



Oriental bittersweet fruits

It is easiest to differentiate invasive from native bittersweet when the plants are flowering or in fruit.

Invasive bittersweet has smaller clusters of flowers (and fruits) in leaf axils while native American bittersweet has larger cluster of flowers (and fruits) at the end of branches.

The invasive and native bittersweets are also known to hybridize, which can make field identification difficult (or impossible!).
