

Field scabiosa look alike

Field scabiosa (*Knautia arvensis*) may be confused with wild bergamot (*Monarda fistulosa*) because their flowerheads look similar.



FIELD SCABIOSA flowerheads are comprised of tiny **4-lobed flowers**.
Opposite leaves are lance elliptic and **coarsely toothed or divided**.
Multiple stems from the base of the plant, **densely hairy, often with purple spots**.



WILD BERGAMOT flowerheads are comprised of tiny **tubular flowers** with a wide lower lip and thin upper lip.
Opposite leaves are **coarsely toothed, but not divided**.
Stems are **square and reddish brown**.
Plant has **distinct aromatic smell**.
