## Garden yellow loosestrife look alikes



Garden yellow loosestrife (*Lysimachia vulgaris*) is one of several *Lysimachia* species with yellow flowers.



GARDEN YELLOW LOOSESTRIFE
has branching clusters of cup-shaped
flowers that are bright to golden
yellow.

Leaves in **whorls** of 3 or 4, with densely **soft-hairy lower surface**.

Stems are **softly hairy**.



swamp Loosestrife (Lysimachia terrestris) has a looser, spike-like raceme of yellow flowers with reddish lines down the center of each petal and red dots at the base of each petal. Leaves are opposite and covered in tiny dots.

Stems are **smooth**. **Reddish bulbils** that look like caterpillars can form in leaf axils late in the season.
